To all Pathfinder club and Youth leaders in the BUC:-

Dear friends,

The British Union has proposed a plan which has been approved by all the presidents to set aside a day when every member of the church is encouraged to distribute 31 pieces of literature into the community where they live or around their church. That is 31000 members - the membership of the BUC - distributing 31 pieces of literature each; resulting in nearly 1 million pieces of literature given out in just one day.

The date set for this venture is Sabbath 25th September, 2010.

I would like to suggest as some have already thought of doing, that where we can, we organise the uniformed Pathfinders and drum corps to be engaged in highlighting this project in your communities. While Pathfinders are marching, young adults could be distributing the literature either door-door or to people on the streets.

This of course is just one way of engaging the youth and Pathfinders - please feel free to think of other creative ways of participating.

Additionally, our young adults may want to consider a festival in a park near your church at which a gospel concert could be performed while the pieces of literature could be handed out to passers-by or just allotting an hour when young adults could blitz a targeted area around the church neighbourhood.
