

Pathfinder Award

We have decided that we would like to honour and recognise those Pathfinders who, over the past few years, have contributed significantly to your club/area or on a regional/conference level. This is **NOT** a Pathfinder of the Year award. This is above and beyond an annual award. Please see below for a list of criteria.

If you have such a person, the protocol is that you must recommend the person's name to your area Pathfinder Co-ordinator, who will submit the best from their area to your conference with accompanying evidence to back the recommendation. The names from both conferences and all the missions will then be looked at by our committee and we will decide on the five that we consider merit the award.

If your Pathfinder has been successful, we will advise you and ask that you both be prepared to be interviewed at Camporee or alternatively, you can submit a DVD to substantiate your recommendation that we can show at the Camporee.

Criteria for Pathfinder Award, BUC Camporee 27 July – 3 August 2008

1. Consistent interest in promoting and being involved in Pathfinders
2. Shows concern for children-youth
3. Conscientious leadership in club/church
4. Lifestyle models principles of pathfinding
5. Assists and support regular club meetings
6. Shows initiative and creativity in progressing the pathfinding work
7. Models spiritual values to peers and those younger
8. Shows respect and support to leadership
9. Has a good reputation outside the church environment
10. Shows willingness to continue training to keep skills current and relevant
11. Is a Master Guide, working on Master Guide or PLA
